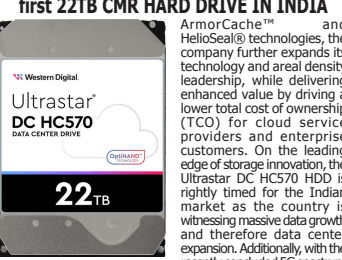

Don't quit BJP, work for AAP: Delhi CM



Rajkot: Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal on Saturday appealed to BJP workers in Gujarat to work for Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) while staying within the ruling party. The AAP national convener said the BJP workers should continue to get "payment" from the BJP while working for AAP "from inside". Addressing a press conference in Rajkot on the final day of his two-day visit to the state, Kejriwal said, "We do not want BJP leaders. The BJP can keep its leaders. BJP's 'panna pramukhs' workers in villages, booths and talukas are joining us in droves. I would like to ask them what the BJP gave them in return for their service in the party even after so many years?" he asked. He said the BJP did not offer free and quality education, healthcare and free electricity to BJP workers and their family members but AAP will care for their welfare. "You (BJP workers) can stay in that party but work for AAP. Many of them get paid by BJP, so take the payment from there but work for us, because we do not have money," he said. He raised the issue of the recent attack on Gujarat AAP general secretary Manoj Sorathiya and apprehended that many more attacks will take place "on the people of Gujarat for supporting AAP".

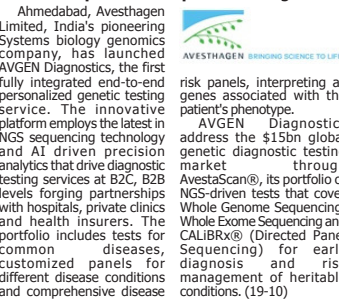

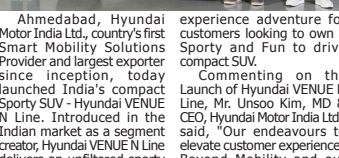

AHMEDABAD: Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Monday promised loan waiver of up to Rs 3 lakh to farmers in Gujarat, LPG cylinder at Rs

Addressing the 'Parivartan Sankalp Rally' in Ahmedabad, Gandhi made a host of promises to people of Gujarat, where the Assembly polls are due later this year, including creation of 10 lakh new jobs, building 3,000 English medium schools and free education to girls. "The BJP government here will waive loans of top industrialists, but have you ever heard that they have waived loans of farmers?" Gandhi asked. "I promise to waive loans of up to Rs 3 lakh of each farmer after we come to power in Gujarat," he said.

polls are due later this year. Gandhi will address the 'Parivartan Sankalp' convention of the Congress' "booth warriors" at the Sabarmati Riverfront in Ahmedabad, party leaders said. He will later visit the Sabarmati Ashram where he will attend a prayer meet and seek blessings of Mahatma Gandhi ahead of the Congress' Bharat Jodo Yatra', he said. Gandhi last visited Gujarat on May 10 when he addressed tributes in Dahod town. This time he will mobilise booth-level Congress workers for the upcoming elections and thereby launch the party's election campaign, the party leaders said. Gandhi's visit to Gujarat comes two days before the party launches the 'Bharat Jodo Yatra' on September 7. The 3,500 km long foot march will cover 12 states and two Union Territories and will be completed in nearly 150 days. The Congress has prepared a three-month-long campaign for the Gujarat assembly elections due later this year, party leaders said. Senior Congress leaders Priyanka Gandhi Vadra and Rahul Gandhi will campaign during this period, they said. The party aims to release its first list of candidates by September 15, they added.

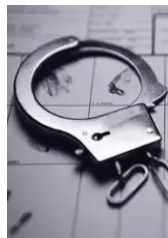

Gujarat ATS arrests Afghan national with 4 kg heroin worth Rs 20 crore from Delhi

Ahmedabad: Gujarat Anti-Terror Squad (ATS) arrested an Afghan national with 4 kg of heroin worth Rs 20 crore from the Vasant Kunj area in the national capital, informed Gujarat Police on Sunday. The accused has been identified as Wadiullah Rahimulla. "Based on the information provided by Surat Crime Branch unit to Gujarat ATS, an Afghani named Wadiullah Rahimulla was arrested with 4 kg of heroin from Vasant Kunj area of Delhi," said police. A case under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act has been registered against the accused. Earlier on Friday, the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) seized 200 kg of ganja worth Rs 4 crore and a vehicle used for transportation have been seized and one person arrested," said NCB officials. As per reports, the drug was being transported

to Mumbai and adjoining areas. Assam Police had also seized a huge quantity of contraband drugs worth Rs 12 lakh and apprehended two drug peddlers in the Karimganj district on late Thursday night. Based on secret information, a team of Karimganj district police led by Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) Githartha Dev Sarma launched an operation and intercepted a four-wheeler in the Bhandara area in the district and seized 131 grams of heroin and three packets of Yaba tablets weighing about 66 grams from the vehicle. Last month, the Assam Police had seized 92.55 kg of ganja and arrested one police. According to Police, the arrested person has been identified as Koilash Das.

Gujarat fastest among states in probing offences



VADODARA: Mumbai police has long held the reputation of being one of the best investigating agencies in the country. But when it comes to completing investigations and disposing of cases, Gujarat tops the charts. In the past three years, pendency percentage of police cases in the state has been the lowest in the country, Gujarat fastest among states in probing offences. According to the National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) report, in 2020, the state had only 1.7 per cent of the cases pending in investigation. Last year, the police disposed of 4.65 lakh cases and only 8,272 cases were pending in investigations by the end of

just 4.5 per cent that was the lowest in the country. In the same year, 520 cases were stayed during investigation. Senior police officials cited a few reasons for the speedy investigations and filing of charge-sheets across the state. "One of the key reasons is that we have separate teams that work on big economic or property-related offences and focus on specific cases. If the case is of serious nature, it is either handed over to the branch or other special squad which completes the investigations swiftly," said a police official. "Another reason is the regular supervising and pressure by senior police officials who insist that the pending cases be investigated quickly and accused be arrested. In some cases, the cops first track down the accused while filing the FIR and hence charge-sheets are filed within the stipulated time after collecting the other evidence," the official added. An FIR in Gandhinagar too gives priority to Gujarat police in some cases. "We also file the charge-sheet in some cases and make a note that an FSL report will be added once the police gets it," the official said. Why justice for Gujarat 2002 riots seems elusive today

The remission of the life sentences of the 11 convicts in the Bilkis Bano case comes as a powerful reminder of a key dimension of the post-2002 Gujarat violence scenario — the guilty men and women went to jail only because of the then Supreme Court.

Bilkis, who was five months pregnant when she was gang raped by neighbours on March 3, 2002, after witnessing the murder of 15 members of her family including her three-year-old daughter, had tried to lodge a complaint the following day for rape and murder. While recording her complaint, the police only mentioned seven of the deaths, claiming that the bodies of the other people could not be found, and refused to record her complaint for rape. The case was closed in January 2003 for lack of evidence.

Bilkis, with the support of several NGOs, including Janvikas and the National Human Rights Commission, petitioned the Supreme Court (SC), which directed the Gujarat government of Gujarat to

reopen the case in September 2003. The police then began a campaign of moral harassment, even waking her in the middle of the night to return to the location of the rape and murders to re-enact the events. In December 2003, the SC directed the CBI to reopen the case. It finally arrested 12 people for rape and murder and six police officers for obstruction of justice. Facing threats, Bilkis sought the transfer of the case in July, to which the SC agreed and a public prosecutor was appointed by the Centre in August 2004. Eventually, the case was tried in Mumbai and in 2008, 13 of the 20 accused were convicted, with 11 of them being given life sentences.

The SC did not stop there. The Best Bakery Case, named for a bakery in Vadodra where 14 people were burnt alive on March 1, 2002, had persuaded the apex court that, in this case too, victims would not get justice in Gujarat. On April 12, 2004, invalidating the High Court (HC), which had granted a retrial outside Gujarat and

Murder in the sewer: the roles of manual cleaning of sewage
